As with the similarly designed SECUMAX COUPPY, the blade is positioned at a 45° degree angle to the cutting material. An optimal angle for the easy cutting of paper and film. The blade remains safely concealed throughout.

Practical assistant

The SECUMAX SNITTY is small, light and handy. Its round handle sits on a sliding base, which is slanted at the front. This makes access to individual paper and film layers easier.

Change safely

The SECUMAX SNITTY fits into every hand. Yours too. The rounded plastic handle does not differentiate between left and right. Try it out and see!

Left and right

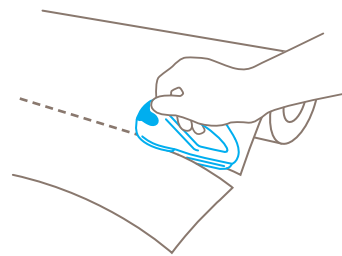
Your safety knife is fitted with a 0.2 mm thin quality blade. You can turn it and turn it around many times – and thus quadruple your usage time. It's worth it for you.

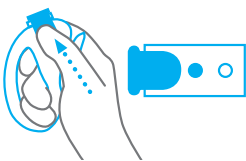

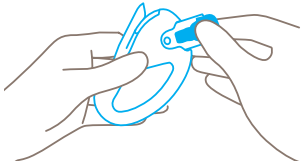

BLADE CHANGE



Use your thumb to push the blade change button out of the handle.



Turn the knife and remove the blade carrier. Turn or change the blade. Ensure that the blade is placed exactly on the locating lug.

1. Usage advice: Please use the product carefully for described work only and not for any purposes other than those that are intended. Please take the correct handling and the proper use of the cutting tool into account in this regard.

2. Special application Instructions to avoid the danger of injuries: Only use cutting tools that are in perfect condition and have sharp, clean and undamaged blades. Employ the utmost care when handling the knives. **CAUTION: The blade is sharp and can result in serious and deep cuts. Therefore, never reach into the blade!** To reduce the danger of injuries, hold the hand that is being used to restrain and stabilise the

cutting base in such a manner that the restraining hand or even other body parts are not endangered in the event that the knife slips. Do not modify this product in any way. Modifications of any kind may impair product safety. **CAUTION:** The risk of injury caused by manipulation of this product is extremely high. When both cutting edges are no longer sharp, dispose of the knife as general waste.

3. Non-use of the knife: Store the knife in a secure place.

4. Care instructions: Always keep the knife clean and do not expose it to unnecessary humidity to safeguard a long service life.

CAUTION: No liability will be assumed for consequential losses. Subject to technical changes and errors! This knife does not belong in the hands of children!

ACCESSORIES

TOOL RETRACTOR

NO. 9960



The TOOL RETRACTOR protects your cutting tool from loss and from falling down. Its core is the heavy-duty Kevlar cord that can be extended up to 90 cm. As soon as you let go of your knife, it is returned to you via the flexible cord. Your hands are free for other activities – the knife always remains at hand. The carabiner is designed for your belt loop, the Kevlar look at the other end fits through the eyelet of your cutting tool.

USED BLADE CONTAINER

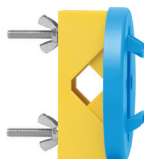

You can fill the USED BLADE CONTAINER with the content of your SAFEBOX. Or directly with your used blades. When the box is full, turn the lid until it shuts. Now the box cannot be reopened. The next step is to safely and completely dispose of the filled USED BLADE CONTAINER as normal waste.

Include it in your order now! With this mounting bracket you can fix your USED BLADE CONTAINER to a central location. Use the clamp and screws and nuts supplied with the product to attach it to either a pipe or a rod.

SAFEBOX

The SAFEBOX is large enough to store a large number of used blades safely. And at the same time, it is compact enough to carry with you. The two slits are not only used for filling, but also to „shorten“ your snap-off blades. When your SAFEBOX is full, empty it into your USED BLADE CONTAINER.
